So then, when the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God.

Mark 16:19

**Greetings Grace Family!** 

For every Christian, Easter Sunday marks a day of celebration and reflection. It is the day that all believers set aside to rejoice the fact that Jesus conquered the grave and even death itself. Easter is the day that God promised and the day the prophets wrote about.

I've often heard people discuss which day is more significant, Easter or Christmas. The day we as believers seem to overlook is the day Jesus ascended back into heaven. One day when Jesus' disciples were confused about some of His teachings, Jesus basically said "if you are having trouble with this, what are you going to do when you see me ascending to where I was before?" Jesus had told them earlier that He had indeed come down from heaven not to do His will, but to do the will of His Father.

The ascension of Jesus Christ is meaningful for several reasons. First, it signaled the end of His earthly ministry. God The Father had lovingly sent His Son into the world at Bethlehem and it was now time for the Son to return to the Father. Jesus was leaving this earth and going to go to heaven to be seated at the right hand of His Father, and then the mission of Christ was to be taken up by His followers.

The disciples knew that Jesus would be leaving, He had told them as much, but it happened so suddenly and without warning. The Bible tells us that as soon as Jesus finished talking, Jesus lifted up into the clouds and into heaven. The disciples "beheld" Him as He was taken up into a cloud. What an amazing sight that must have been!

Then, as the disciples gazed into the heavens, two angels appeared and asked why they were just standing there. Jesus had given them their instructions and they should get moving. They also told them that Jesus would return in the same way He left. Jesus allowed the disciples to witness Him ascend into heaven. But before He left, Jesus spent 40 days here on earth to stabilize the faith of the disciples and prepare them for a future with Him in heaven.

Easter is not just one day out of the year, it's a 40 day celebration. Just like we celebrate Lent for the 40 days before Easter, we get to celebrate Jesus resurrection for a full 40 days after Easter Sunday. And just in case that's not enough, we'll continue to celebrate it the rest of the year too!
