I trust in you with all my heart. Don't let me wander away from your commands.
Psalm 119:10

When my family and I lived in Alaska, we had a neighbor that had kids about the same age as Lillian and Bethy. These neighbors also had two small dogs that provided a vast amount of entertainment! One of the dogs, who was named "Rocko," was so small that when a hawk or an eagle flew overhead we would all run to make sure he was safe and not end up as an easy snack for one of those huge birds. We sometimes still quote the mom of that family when she said "watch out for Rocko, you know how he tends to wander!"

Those are words of wisdom for all of us. I feel we all have a tendency to wander. The textbook definition of *wander* is 'to move about aimlessly.' If we were to be completely honest, the word wander might be an accurate description of many aspects of our lives. We often go about portions of our lives without a clear purpose or any real objective. It's like when I go grocery shopping without a list or even a real idea of what we're out of or what's on sale. I might come back with several full bags of food, but then struggle to find something to make for supper! Some of the times we "tend to wander off" can be easily fixed by making (and bringing) a shopping list, or mapping out how to get from point "A" to point "B".

In the same way, we can easily wander off the path that God has planned for us. We might say that we have a relationship with God, but do we have a real purpose and a real objective for that relationship? Have you ever thought of making a list of things you want to accomplish in your walk with the Creator of the universe? Have you ever thought about mapping out a course of direction that will lead you closer to Him?

God promises to help you with all of that if you will simply seek Him out and then trust Him to lead you down the right path. Try starting with these words from Proverbs 3:5-6 – *Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will direct your path.*

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Motion by Andy Mercier, second by Allie McDonald to approve the report.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Andy Shamburek provided a paper report to be reviewed by the group. We are only 16 days into the new year. We will have a better picture of our finances by next month's meeting. Motion by Grace Shamburek and second by Brooke Siolka to approve the report.

OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS:

- **Benevolences** – Holli provided a list with the beneficiaries, amounts and years supported. The budgeted amount of benevolence giving is 12% of all expenses combined. The amount for 2023 will be \$30,534. Jeff Schullo suggested that we add the International Children's Fund, out of Neenah, WI, to our giving list. He will provide additional information about their organization at our next meeting.
- **Furnace Replacement** – we had problems with 3 furnaces during the holidays- the exchanger was plugged in one, the gas valves had to be replaced in one furnace and the blower motor in the other. Kent received a quote to replace all 3 for a total of \$9,335. Jennifer Lyng made a motion to approve the replacement of the 3 furnaces with funds available in our Building Fund. Jeff Schullo seconded it.
- **Lenten Schedule** – Holli provided a copy of the 2023 Lenten schedule detailing the services and meals.

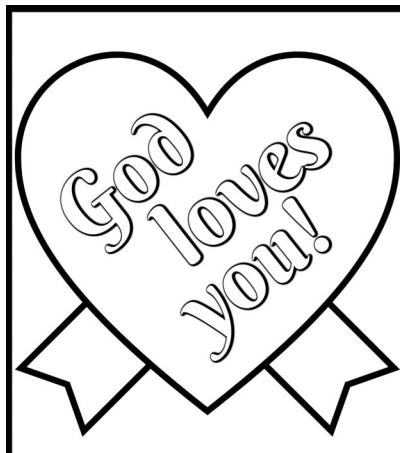

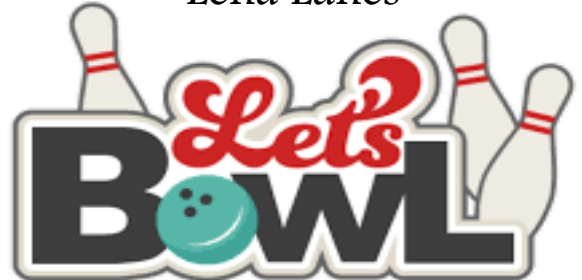

A Deeper Relationship with God

Have you ever felt like you would like a deeper relationship with Jesus? Many of the members of Grace Lutheran Church have found that relationship through a movement called *Via de Cristo*. The aim of *Via de Cristo* is to show pastors and lay people the love of God through a very intense weekend. The *Via de Cristo* weekends take place at one of two camps - Silver Birch Ranch and Camp Forest Springs.

During the three days of *Via de Cristo*, attendees listen to 14 talks given by laypeople and clergy. Following each talk, small group table discussions focus on the main points of the talk. In an overlapping fashion, the talks present various aspects of the Christian life, based on the person and teachings of Jesus Christ as an ideal.

People from all walks of life grow closer to one another during the *Via de Cristo* weekend. They worship, listen, and sing in a joyful family atmosphere. Men and women will be separated for most activities including learning, discussing, and sleeping at separate locations within the camp. A spirit of fellowship and a rustic camp atmosphere makes for a special weekend. Good food and snacks are abundant.
