Greetings Grace Family,

Wisconsin is an amazingly beautiful place. When I was growing up on the western side of the state, my cousins from Virginia would visit us and say they were coming to "God's country". Part of what makes Wisconsin so desirable and so beautiful is the fact that we have four distinct and separate seasons. Each season brings its own unique beauty and character for us to enjoy.

In the book of Ecclesiastes chapter 3, God Himself tells us that there are seasons for everything. A time to cry and a time to laugh; a time to grieve and a time to dance. This is not only true in our seasons of the year, but also in our day to day lives and in the life of the Church year as well.

We are about move out of the season of Epiphany and enter into what we call the season of Lent. Like all Church seasons, Lent brings a unique opportunity for us to grow closer to God and to grow stronger in our relationship with Him. Lent is a time for reflection, a time for repentance, and a time to remember what God has accomplished for us during His time here on this earth. He offered Himself up for the forgiveness of our sins so that we are made new again in Him.

During this time, you may want to consider either abstaining from something in your life or adding something beneficial to your life. This isn't an attempt to get God's attention or to try to gain His favor, rather it's a reaction to what God offers each of us and a sign of acknowledgement and respect of His generosity.

Lent is a season of growth. A time to grow in our faith and trust for the creator of the universe. Our Lenten suppers also offer us a time to grow closer to other believers and to reach out to those who don't already know their personal Lord and Savior. I challenge you all to invite friends, family and coworkers to our Wednesday night gatherings. It's a wonderful time for us all to gather together to discover more about God's promises and how they play out in our lives.

**Grace Lutheran Council Meeting Minutes
January 15th, 2024 @ 7:00pm**

Meeting was called to order by President Jared Alfson at 7:05pm.

Present: Jared Alfson, Kent Lyng, Heidi Anderson, Andy Shamburek, Jeff Schullo, Ellen Pritzlaff, Andy Mercier, Jerry Riste, Melanie Rice

Absent: Allie McDonald, Pastor Gary Olson, Lyle Nichols

Guest: Holli Kussow

Opening Prayer and Devotion: Jared Alfson

Secretary's Report: A motion was made by Andy Mercier and seconded by Melanie Rice to approve the December 2023 minutes without correction. Motion approved.

Treasurer's Report: Andy Shamburek provided a paper report detailing a net ordinary income of \$10, 119.33. Our total giving as of 1/15/24 is approximately \$11, 810.87. A motion was made by Jerry Riste and seconded by Ellen Pritzlaff to approve the treasurer's report. Motion approved.

Old Business:

- 2024 Benevolences - Council discussed keeping the total amount of benevolences at \$30,000 (roughly 12.5% of the church's tithes and offerings) and to make the following changes: *remove the benevolences given to the OF Ambulance and the Lake Lundgren Bible Camp, reduce the Sunshine Fund to a total of \$2400/yr and the Sioux Falls Seminary to \$1200/yr, and add The 1 Human Fund at \$1200/yr, the Josiah Venture at \$1200/yr, and the Grace OCC Ministry at \$2780/yr. Heidi Anderson made a motion to accept these changes to Grace Lutheran's Benevolences for 2024, Jeff Schullo seconded it. Motion passed.*

New Business:

- **Ellen Pritzlaff - 2024 Operation Christmas Child (OCC)** - Ellen Pritzlaff intends to increase the number of OCC boxes Grace Lutheran puts together to a total of 600 for 2024. She would like to purchase a soccer ball kit (the soccer ball has several languages on it praising God and comes with its own pump) from the "WOW" company for each of the 600 boxes this month and requested \$2000. A motion was made by Ellen Pritzlaff and seconded by Jerry Riste to receive the \$2000 as an advanced payment from the newly created Grace OCC Ministry Benevolence fund. Votes: 2 in favor, 4 opposed and 1 abstained. Motion failed. A motion was made by Andy Mercier and seconded by Melanie Rice to give Ellen Pritzlaff/Grace Lutheran OCC \$2000 from the church's account but NOT from the Grace OCC Ministry Benevolence fund. Votes: 5 in favor, 1 opposed and 1 abstained. Motion approved.
- **New Phone System** - Holli Kussow requested permission to change the provider for the church's phone system. Since the current phone system has been experiencing unresolvable issues, she has looked into new providers. Holli requested permission to change the phone system provider to Nsight and provided the following information: this provider is internet based, has a 1x cost of \$690 for installation and a monthly payment of \$102, provides battery back ups in case of a power outage, has unlimited extensions, provides 'voicemail to read' via email, and comes with 3 new phones. More information about the elevator phone through the new provider will need to be obtained. The church's current phone provider costs \$165 per month. A motion was made by Ellen Pritzlaff and seconded by Andy Mercier to change the church's phone system to Nsight. Motion approved.

Committee Reports (if any)

1. **Evangelism** - Jeff Schullo submitted a written report: the Evangelism Committee did not meet during the Christmas season, but plans to meet soon to discuss upcoming events planned for this spring. The "To God's Glory Luncheon" for January was canceled due to a snowstorm, but Randy and Yvonne Nelson had put together lasagna and froze it to be served at the February 13th luncheon. A special thank you to all of the church members who had helped with buying the bread, cheese, noodles and desserts for the luncheon. The committee put together "Welcome" gift bags to be handed out to any new people visiting the church; these bags will be in Holli's office and available to hand out starting this Sunday. Jeff has added snap bracelets to these bags for the kids to enjoy.
2. **Parish Education** - Heidi Anderson reported JAM resumed classes on 1/7 and intends to continue to reach out to parents and the parish for help in leading and assisting the lessons taught during JAM. She will plan a lesson for this spring to teach the kids in JAM about OCC.
3. **Parish Fellowship** - Andy Mercier reported no update at this time.
4. **Property & Maintenance** - Kent Lyng submitted a written report: several small maintenance items were taken care of in the past month (including the repair of a leaking toilet, refastening metal trim outdoors and upgrading a few fluorescent light bulbs with LED bulbs). There is still a need to have people assist with outside maintenance activities for the fall and winter months (duties include snow blowing, clearing snow from entrances, and making sure sidewalks are clear of ice and snow).
5. **Public Relations** - no update at this time.
6. **Stewardship** - Jared Alfson reported a low interest in small groups at this time but the committee is discussing ideas for the future. Fellowship Sunday on 12/31/23 was a success. The church directory is still in need of some pictures before it can be finalized; projected done taking pictures by the end of February. Council members will have their directory picture taken at the February Council meeting. The committee is currently working on creating "serving teams" for each service to

service to cover all the needed positions.

7. **Youth Ministry** - no report at this time; Silver Birch Ranch retreat coming up in February.

8. **Worship & Music** - Holli Kussow reported the committee reviewed the Advent and Christmas services and made revisions for 2024; attendance at the Christmas services were successful, with over 300 people at the 4pm Christmas Eve service. Kelly is currently looking into bringing a brass quintet in to perform at both Easter services. A new organist, Nick, started on 1/7 and will continue to play during the first service for the month of January and February. An event calendar for 2024 was provided and a Lenten Calendar for 2024 was provided.

9. **Endowment** - Melanie Rice reported the committee will be meeting in the upcoming weeks to discuss how to disperse the money they have received.

10. **Long Range Planning** - Jerry Riste reported he has met with the church's men and women groups, but would still like to meet with Pastor about new ideas before presenting them to council.

11. **Pastor's Report** - no update at this time.

Andy Mercier made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Kent Lyng seconded it. Motion approved. Closed with the Lord's Prayer at 8:52pm.
