During five sessions, we demonstrated the power of Jesus and showed them how He works in the lives of those who follow Him and put their trust in Him.

In case you somehow missed it, our theme this year was titled "*STELLAR*" and the main point was "Shine Jesus' Light!" It gives me goosebumps just thinking about all those young people shouting that at the top of their lungs!
